#### **GUIDELINES**

#### **Candidates Must:**

- Essay Contest runs April 6, 2022 May 6, 2022.
- Submit their essay by May 6, 2022 at 5:00pm via e-mail. Late submissions will be automatically disqualified.
- Type the essay; handwritten essays will not be accepted.
- Be a student in high school in the Austin-Round Rock-San Marcos Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) and the principal cites of Austin, Round Rock, Georgetown, Leander, Jollyville, Bastrop, Pflugerville, Del Valle, Garfield, Jonestown, Lago Vista, Lakeway, Manchaca, Manor, Rollingwood, and West Lake Hills.
- \* Have an interest in money management skills (decision-making related to spending and saving, investing, use of credit, etc.) appropriate for their age and grade level.
- Demonstrate how they practice good money management skills in their daily lives.
- ❖ Be able to "think on their feet" and respond to questions from business leaders.
- Be articulate: able to speak in front of large groups and cameras, and respond well to questions.
- ❖ Have a valid social security number.

## To Apply:

- The essay submission deadline is May 6, 2022 at 5:00pm via e-mail.
- Students must have parent, guardian, teacher, or community leader's permission to apply and participate.
- Student must write an essay on the assigned topic. Include student's first and last name at the footer of each page.
- ❖ High School, minimum of 500 words and no more than 600 words.
- ❖ Essays should be typed on plain white paper, one −sided, and double-spaced. The \$mart Kid Essay Application Form must be attached at the front of the essay.
- The essay must be the sole work of the student.
- The application form must be signed by the teacher/community leader, and a parent/guardian.
